into trousers**

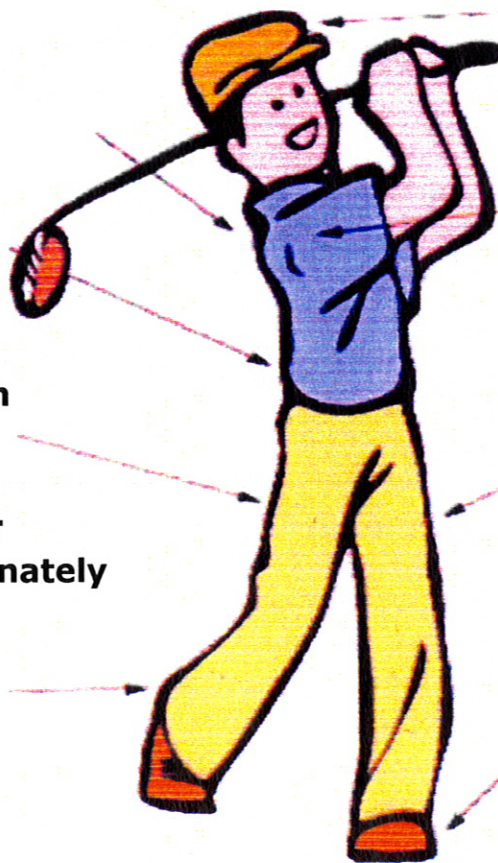
**Shorts must be

Dress Code

Copthorne Golf Club seeks to promote a friendly, relaxed atmosphere in which members and their guests can enjoy the course and clubhouse facilities. The Committee reminds members, guests and visitors that a reasonable standard of dress is required at all times.

Inappropriate or unacceptable dress is any attire which staff or a Committee Member, at their discretion, considers being unsuitable. Guidelines are set out below:

On the Course

Mobile phones may be taken on the course for use in **EMERGENCIES ONLY**

Acceptable

Recognized golf dress
Sleeveless shirts with a collar (ladies)
White short socks & ultra low socks may be worn with tailored shorts
Shirts must be tucked in at all times

Not Acceptable

Any denim material
Tracksuits or football shirts
Tee shirts or shirts without a collar, other than recognized golf shirts
Shorts other than smart tailored
Footwear not specifically designed for golf

In the Clubhouse Lounge and Dining Areas

Mobile Phones may not be used in the Clubhouse

Acceptable

Smart clean casual dress, including tailored shorts

Summer shoes & closed toe sandals without socks, open toe sandals worn with socks(men)

Smart casual dress is acceptable in the Dining Room, on Wednesday Evenings & Sunday Lunch

Otherwise after 6pm Jacket & Tie must be worn

Not Acceptable

Any denim material
Tracksuits or football shirts
Tee shirts or shirts without a collar, other than recognized golf shirts
Golfing footwear or Trainers
Beach style "flip flops"
Headgear of any kind

Posters advertising Social Functions will state any dress restrictions/relaxation at that time

We respectfully ask that members, guests and visitors comply with the Dress Code out of respect for others and do not put our staff in a position where it is necessary for them to bring the policy to your attention.

All members are requested to ensure that these standards are maintained. Anyone found not complying with this policy will not be permitted to play golf or enter the clubhouse. Staff have been instructed to enforce this policy and will be happy to assist you with any enquiries you may have. Any grievances should be referred to the Club Secretary.
